

When we gain access to the site we will need lots of support to help get this up and running ready for September. More details to follow about this exciting new partnership in the coming months.

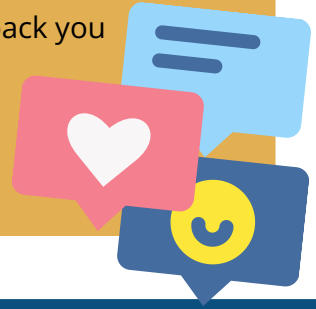
