- Internally, we have been creating new procedures ourselves within the club, including setting out our approach to game time, so all coaches and members can be clear on expectations on this matter. In summary, this outlines how any player, up to and including U11, should expect equal game time across the squad on a match day. For the older age groups U12+, our fair game time standards expects at least each player to get a minimum of 50% playing time within any match.
